**Historical Note**

September 11, 2001 (9/11) was a series of coordinated terrorist attacks against the United States of America. On the morning of Tuesday, September 11, 2001, four passenger airplanes were hijacked by terrorists: two planes – American Airlines Flight 11 and United Airlines Flight 175 – crashed into the North and South towers of the World Trade Center complex in New York City; American Airlines Flight 77 crashed into the Pentagon in Arlington County, Virginia; and United Airlines Flight 93, initially hijacked and flown toward Washington, D.C., crashed in Stonycreek Township, near Shanksville, Pennsylvania, after passengers regained control of the aircraft. Memorials in remembrance of the 2,977 fatalities, include: National September 11 Memorial & Museum in New York City; the Pentagon Memorial in Arlington County, Virginia; and the Flight 93 National Memorial at the Pennsylvania crash site.

**Scope and Content**

The September 11, 2001 (9/11) Memorial Collection is housed in one archival box, and which contains correspondence, photographs, and publications associated with September 11, 2001, and the subsequent memorial programs at Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and information from the Flight 93 National Memorial. This collection also contains paper and electronic copies of information from IUP publications and audio/visual recordings associated with the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks and memorial programs.
