Stringfellow Barr

Stringfellow Barr, distinguished educator, speaker, and historian, served as president of St. John's College at Annapolis from 1937 to 1947. Here, to remedy what he refers to as the "Higher Illiteracy," he inaugurated the famous Great Books Program. Using an idea conceived with Robert Hutchins and Mortimer Adler at the University of Chicago the year before, he abolished the elective system and began his "Great Books: curriculum, an all-required course of studies with heavy emphasis on mathematics and science. In 1940 he carried his educational ideas into the medium of mass communication when he conceived and began CBS Radio's still continuing program "Invitation to Learning." In 1958 he published Purely Academic, a satirical novel on American college education. In the same year, while serving as Professor of Human-ities at Rutgers University, he was working on The Will of Zeus, the first of his books about the Hellenic culture. At Rutgers, he was given the Lindback Award for Distinguished Teaching. A long-time student of public affairs, Mr. Barr served for a number of years as head of a foundation concerned with economic development, during which time he traveled widely in Latin America, Asia, and Africa. The perspec-tives gained from these travels largely shaped his interest in U. S. foreign policy, about which he wrote the internationally popular Citizens of the World and Let's Join The Human Race. Historical works include Mazzini: Portrait of an Exile and The Pilgrimage of Western Man. His interest in ecumenism led to his contributing to "American Catholics: A Protestant-Jewish View" and to "Religion in America." His hobbies produced two books, The Kitchen-Garden Book and a children's story, Copydog in India. He has also written for The Atlantic Monthly, The Nation, The New Republic, The Progressive, The Saturday Review and others.
