# Commencement Speaker Robert E. Cook



obert Cook spent his career as a serial entrepreneur in computer software. His first company was VM Software, later named System Center, which was founded in 1981, listed on both the NASDAQ stock market and the New York Stock Exchange, and sold in 1993. He acted as a seed investor, CEO advisor, and board member of several other software companies and was president of the software division of the Association of Data Processing Services Organization, the trade group for the industry.

Mr. Cook served as a Regular Army officer from 1964 until 1969 with service in Europe, Vietnam, and Washington, D.C. He holds the Bronze Star, Army Commendation Medal, and the parachutist's badge.

Mr. Cook endowed the Robert E. Cook Honors College of Indiana University of Pennsylvania in 1993 with the largest donation in the history of IUP and has been actively involved with its nurturing since that time, with additional funding for specific projects and programs. Mr. Cook is also the primary funder for the Cook Honors College Achievement Program, which provides assistance for Honors College students to study abroad and to undertake enrichment activities such as internships and independent research that have proven important in gaining scholarships and other awards that distinguish scholarly and professional performance.

Mr. Cook and his wife, Paula Brooks, are active vintners in St. Helena, California. They planted and actively manage the Dancing Hares Winery, which produces an estate-bottled wine that is blended with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, and Petit Verdot varieties of red wine grapes and was mentioned as "a cult wine to watch" by the San Francisco Chronicle.

Mr. Cook received a B.S. degree in 1964 from Indiana University of Pennsylvania and an MBA from George Washington University. He is a recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award from the IUP Alumni Association and was awarded an honorary Doctor of Laws degree by IUP in 2000.

efore becoming president of Indiana University of Pennsylvania, Tony Atwater served as provost and vice president for Academic Affairs at Youngstown State University, Youngstown, Ohio. He earned a Ph.D. in communication research from Michigan State University, where he was the recipient of a competitive doctoral fellowship. Dr. Atwater's research interest is news selection behavior in the mass media. He has published approximately thirty refereed journal articles on the subject. He completed postdoctoral study in the Department of Communication at the University of Michigan.

Dr. Atwater earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in mass media arts (magna cum laude) from Hampton University and a master's degree from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University. He is the recipient of three graduate certificates in higher education administration from the Harvard Graduate School of Education.

Earlier administrative assignments included roles as dean of the College of Education at Northern Kentucky University, chairperson of the Rutgers University Department of Journalism and Mass Media, and associate vice president for Academic Affairs at the University of Toledo. Dr. Atwater's experience also includes eight years of work in radio and television as a news reporter and director. In addition to his professional work, Dr. Atwater has assumed numerous significant community leadership roles throughout his career.

# David J. LaPorte

David LaPorte has taught at Indiana University of Pennsylvania since 1995. He also holds appointments at the Maryland Psychiatric Research Center, the University of Maryland School of Medicine Department of Psychiatry, and Indiana Regional Medical Center.

Teaching primarily at the graduate level, Dr. LaPorte has three priorities in teaching—superior knowledge of content, respect for the scientific literature, and connecting with students. He has directed seven master's theses and twenty-three completed dissertations and is overseeing seven more dissertations in progress. Through his teaching, he wants to make a difference in his students' academic and professional development.

Dr. LaPorte writes, "Ideally, in every class I teach, there will be one student who will be changed in some way by the course material as I present it." After this connection is made, many of his students stay in touch. Their testimonials show that his enthusiasm for his field inspires them to take additional courses in Psychology. Dr. LaPorte becomes a true mentor for students, helping them to find a direction for their research and careers, pointing them to opportunities for scholarship and employment, and supporting them through academic and other challenges.

# DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARD FOR SERVICE

#### Jonathan B. Smith

Since joining the Department of Health and Physical Education in the fall of 1997, Jonathan B. Smith has demonstrated his commitment to service at all levels of the university and to the regional community through his many outstanding service leadership roles. Among his contributions are the five years he served as chair of the IUP Senate, six years as Senate webmaster, two years as Senate secretary, and three years on the University Wide Promotions Committee and his service as the current chair of the Academic Computing Policy and Advisory Committee.

In addition, Dr. Smith annually organizes several major YMCA and high school swimming competitions, including the IUP Kickoff Classic, Indiana High School Invitational, and YMCA Christmas Tree invitational. These meets host approximately three thousand competitors, some of whom are prospective IUP students. They provide a superb opportunity for service learning for IUP Health and Physical Education majors to participate in managing all aspects of large-scale athletic competitions.

Dr. Smith has worked with Aging Services of Indiana County since 2006 to implement and instruct a senior citizens' aquatic fitness program, has been a member of the committee for a Strategic Plan for Indiana Area School District, has served as a volunteer scuba instructor for the Boy Scouts, and has coordinated the aquatic staff for Habitat for Humanity's Jackie Kallal Triathlon. Dr. Smith is also a member of the editorial board of the International Journal of Aquatic Research and Education.



# Distinguished Faculty Award for Research Abbas J. Ali

Abbas Ali, professor of Management, has been employed by Indiana University of Pennsylvania since 1989. Previously, he taught at Indiana University and Saginav 1989. Previously, he taught at Indiana University at South Bend, Fort Hays State University, and Saginaw Valley State University and has been a Eulbrick to a south Bend, Fort Hays State University, and Visiting Valley State University and has been a Fulbright Senior Scholar at the University of Jordan and Visiting Professor of Management at the University of Sharjah and the University of Calgary.

The themes of Dr. Ali's research are critical and timely, including competitiveness in the global environment and cross-cultural studios of the environment and cross-cultural studies of managers. Dr. Ali has third most prolific writer in the international Business recognized as early as 1998 by naming mines published two scholarly books—Islamic Porcessition and Business and Busin published two scholarly books—Islamic Perspectives on Management and Organization and Business and Management Environment in Saudi Arabia and Management Environment in Saudi Arabia—as well as chapters in scholarly books, eleven articles in refereed journals, and numerous commentarias in the last five year. in refereed journals, and numerous commentaries in the popular press; he has also given twenty-four presentations at national and international conferences.

Dr. Ali has served as editor-in-chief of the International Journal of Commerce and Management, which he founded; Competitiveness Review: Advances in a competition Forum he founded; Competitiveness Review; Advances in Competitiveness Research; and Competition Forum. He has published a variety of instruments to competitiveness Research; and Competition Forum. # The Symbols of Learning



Participants in the commencement procession are attired in regalia that reflects a history and heritage that can be traced to the medieval universities of the eleventh and twelfth centuries. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the Middle Ages to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

Academic life as we know it today began in the Middle Ages, first in the church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the Guild of the Master of Arts, and the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master; their dress was the outward sign of stature and responsibility. Academic regalia was thus a visible manifestation—in color and pattern and design—that unified those of common discipline and like

In later centuries, to preserve the regalia's dignity and meaning, universities set rules of academic dress. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1895 establishing a code of approved attire. In 1932 the American Council on Education revised this code, which, for the most part, governs the style of academic dress today. The principal features of academic dress are three: the gown, the cap,

The Gown. The flowing gown dates to the twelfth century. Many think it was worn as protection against the cold of unheated buildings. It has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress of rank or social standing. It is (with a few institutional exceptions) black for all degrees. Pointed sleeves indicate the bachelor's degree; long closed sleeves with a slit in the arm, the master's degree; and round open sleeves, the doctor's degree. The gown for bachelor's or master's degrees has no trimmings; the gown for the doctorate degree is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves, in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline
