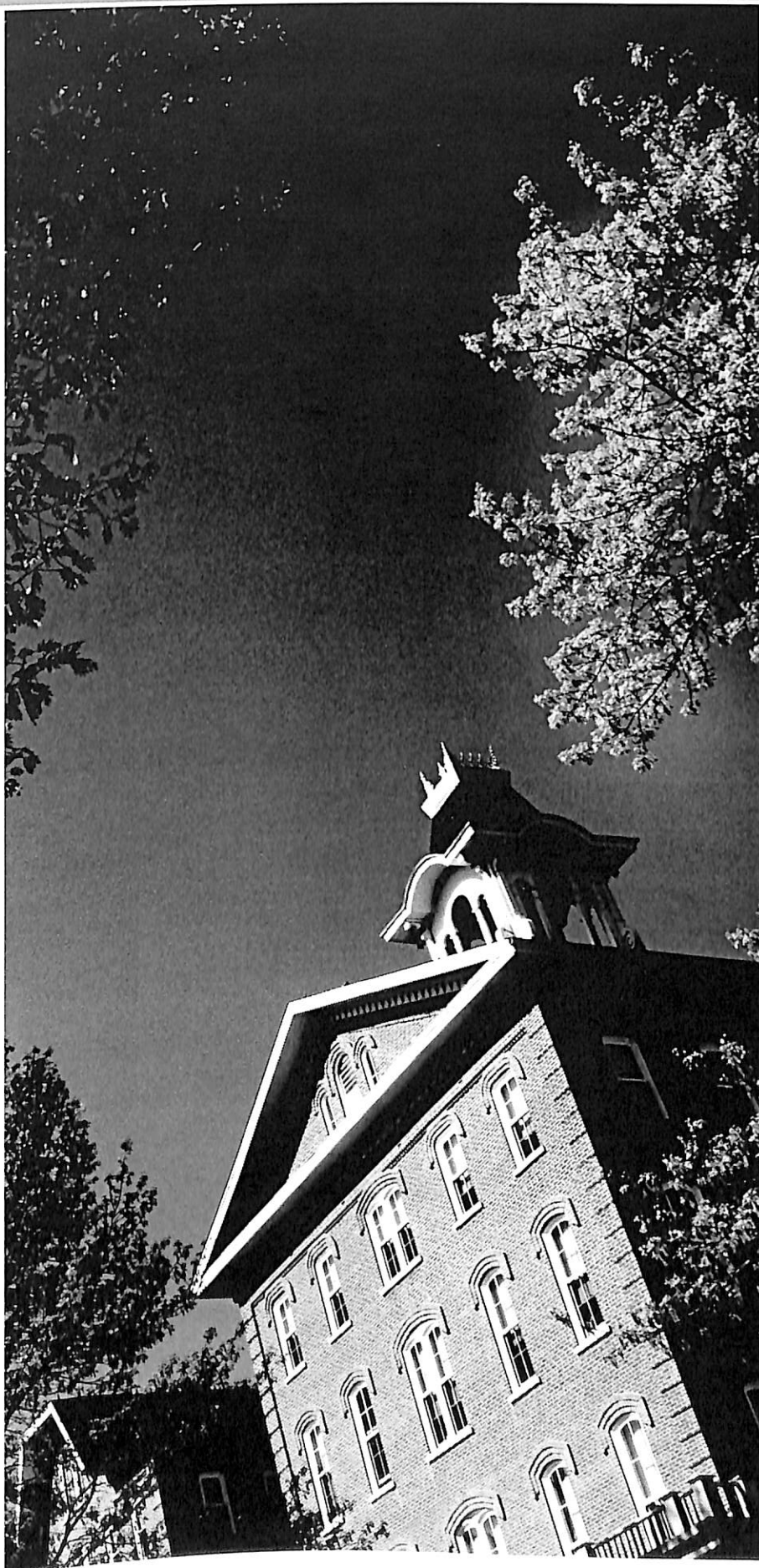

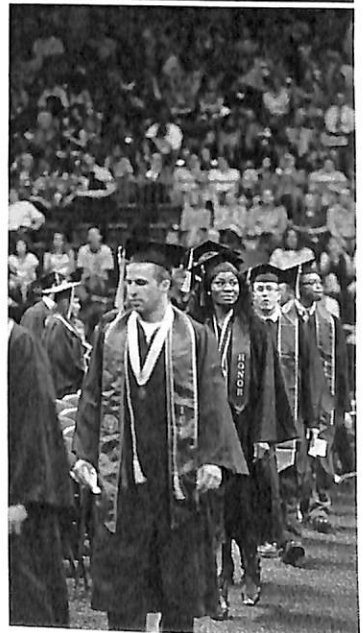

## DONALD J. MASH, KEYNOTE SPEAKER



At today's commencement ceremonies, IUP is honoring Donald J. Mash with an honorary doctor of humane letters degree.

Dr. Mash, a 1964 graduate of Indiana State College, has worked in higher education administration for five decades. Before his retirement in 2008, Dr. Mash served as executive senior vice president for the University of Wisconsin System, a statewide system of 13 four-year campuses, 13 two-year transfer campuses, and a statewide extension. The system enrolls more than 173,000 students.

Since his retirement, Dr. Mash has served the system as executive senior special assistant for chancellor selection and leadership development. In this consulting role, he assists the system's president and board of regents in the selection of chancellors.

Dr. Mash was chancellor of the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire from 1998 to 2005. The university enrolls 10,500 students and offers degrees at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. During his leadership, the university's first comprehensive campaign was successful in raising more than \$50 million.

Before joining the University of Wisconsin System, Dr. Mash served as president of Wayne State College, in Wayne, Nebraska, for 10 years. Under his leadership, the college experienced enhanced student support services, growth in enrollment and faculty positions, widespread computerization, and growth in public service outreach. In addition, the college completed its first comprehensive fundraising campaign and developed its first physical master plan, launching an ambitious construction and renovation cycle.

Dr. Mash also served in leadership roles at George Mason University in Fairfax, Virginia. As vice president for student affairs, he developed a comprehensive student support system and oversaw the university's Division I athletic

program, as well as facilities planning for residence halls, a student center, and recreation and sports facilities. As executive vice president for administration, he was responsible for personnel, facilities planning and management, community relations and development, and aspects of student services, alumni relations, intercollegiate athletics, and special events.

Previously, Dr. Mash served as dean for student services at Ohio Dominican College in Columbus, Ohio. There, he provided leadership at the time the women's college had just become co-educational. He administered a comprehensive student services support program to accompany the institutional change.

Dr. Mash began his career in higher education as an instructor of geography at the University of Pittsburgh-Bradford from 1965 to 1968 and assumed administrative responsibilities concurrent with full-time teaching after his initial year there.

In addition to his BSEd in geography from Indiana State College, Dr. Mash earned a master's degree in geography from the University of Pittsburgh and a PhD in higher education-student development from Ohio State University.

Dr. Mash came to Indiana State College as a first-generation college student from Jeannette. While at ISC, he was a member of Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity. In 1995, IUP honored Dr. Mash with the Distinguished Alumni Award.

## A MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT DRISCOLL



### ABOUT THE PRESIDENT

President Michael A. Driscoll has high expectations for Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

In his first three years, he engaged university stakeholders to ensure IUP's continued excellence and spearheaded efforts to formulate a vision for IUP's future and a subsequent strategic plan. He formed a sustainable natural resource development team composed of scientific and safety experts. The team of professors and students explores ways to respond to the demand for information on safe, profitable energy development. He established the Military Resource Center, which assists veterans and active military personnel and their families with achieving their educational goals. Construction of a new building for humanities and social sciences is under way and is set to be completed this year.

Before his arrival at IUP in 2012, Dr. Driscoll served as executive vice chancellor and provost of the University of Alaska Anchorage, a position he took after serving in various posts at Portland State University in Oregon, including vice provost for Academic Personnel and Budget and executive dean of the Maseeh College of Engineering and Computer Science.

To the Degree Recipients,

When I was finishing my degree, commencement was nowhere near as important to me as it was to my family and friends. My parents made sure I walked across the stage so they could watch.

Looking back, I know that commencement marked an important transition in my life, just as it does for you today. This is the beginning, the commencing, of the next phase of your life. We expect you to take what you have learned and use it to make this world a better place.

### THE UNIVERSITY

Indiana University of Pennsylvania was established in 1875 and is the only doctoral research university in Pennsylvania's State System of Higher Education. IUP has a long tradition of academic excellence and receives frequent accolades, including designation as one of *The Best 379 Colleges* in the 2015 edition of a Princeton Review book by that name. The university provides an intellectually challenging experience to more than 14,000 students at three campuses, all easily accessible from Pittsburgh and the Middle Atlantic region.

Academic offerings include more than 130 undergraduate majors with a variety of internship and study abroad programs, more than 50 master's degree programs, and 12 doctoral degrees. Unusual opportunities for research at all levels and the Robert E. Cook Honors College provide special challenges for academic growth. The variety and quality of instruction are characteristic of a big university, yet at IUP, close, one-to-one relationships develop within the teaching framework, and a strong sense of community prevails.

## DISTINGUISHED UNIVERSITY PROFESSOR



### Maureen C. McHugh, Psychology

Maureen C. McHugh has been selected as the 2015-16 Distinguished University Professor. A professor of psychology at IUP, Dr. McHugh teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in gender and diversity. She was awarded the Christine Ladd Franklin Award for her contributions to feminist psychology and the Florence Denmark Award for Distinguished Mentoring for her research with and mentoring of graduate and undergraduate students. She is also included in *Feminist Voices*, an online history of feminist psychology, and participated in recorded interviews for the project.

Dr. McHugh has contributed extensively to the psychology of women field, as a teacher and a scholar. Acknowledged as a Pioneer in the Teaching of Psychology of Women by the Association of Women in Psychology, she is proud to have taught the subject to more than 3,000 students, because "psychology of women can change our understanding of our own and others' lives," she said.

Dr. McHugh founded the Women's Studies Program at IUP in 1986 and served as director for a dozen years. She advocated for women's studies in the region, offering workshops and conferences to connect women's studies scholars from various regional campuses. She remains actively involved in curriculum design, developing a new course, Gender and Violence, and collaborating on a new minor in violence education. Dr. McHugh coordinated the annual conference of the Association for Women in Psychology in 1997 and is on the planning committee for AWP 2016. She has helped to plan a dozen workshops and conferences for IUP, including the recent Sex and Gender (2012), REACH (2013), and the State System's Psychology Conference (2010 and 2014).

Dr. McHugh has also served in leadership positions at the national level. She was president (equivalent) of the Association for Women in Psychology and chair of the Committee on Women of the American Psychological Association. She is currently president of the APA's Society for Psychology of Women, Division 35. An advocate for women as leaders in the academy, Dr. McHugh developed and conducts the Leadership

Institute for Faculty Women, which has trained 200 women for leadership on the State System's 14 campuses.

Dr. McHugh has published more than 50 book chapters and articles, and her work is included in many psychology of women texts and handbooks. Two of her publications won Distinguished Publication Awards from the AWP.

A continuing focus of her scholarship is violence against women. Dr. McHugh cowrote numerous reviews of literature on intimate partner violence and coedited two special topic journal issues on women and violence. Perceived as an expert in this area, Dr. McHugh has been invited to provide reviews on intimate partner violence, sexual assault, and other forms of violence for handbooks and texts. Her other areas of scholarship currently include the history of feminist psychology, older women, size bias, sexual scripts, and sexual assault. In each of these areas, she has collaborated with graduate students. Her text *The Wrong Prescription for Women*, coedited with Joan C. Chrisler, is a critical examination of the medicalization of women's bodies and lives. It will be published by Praeger this summer.

During her tenure as Distinguished University Professor, Dr. McHugh plans to work on a book or book series about women's sexuality that integrates her previous work and extends the scholarship on women's sexual empowerment. The work will target scholars in the area of gender and sexuality and will reiterate, confirm, and extend contemporary thinking about sexual interactions and cultural practices.

### ABOUT THE AWARD

The Office of the President recognizes one faculty member each year with the Distinguished University Professor Award, based on a record of outstanding teaching, university service, and active and demonstrable engagement in research/scholarly activity that advances his or her discipline or its pedagogy. In addition to the lifetime title, the award earns recipients a grant and a reduced teaching load for one year to allow more time for research and scholarship.

### Distinguished Faculty Award for Teaching

**DeAnna Laverick**, Professional Studies in Education

As a teacher educator, DeAnna Laverick seeks to share her passion for teaching with her students and to inspire them to make a difference in the lives of the children they will teach. A former teacher at Penns Manor Elementary School, Dr. Laverick uses her elementary teaching experience, content knowledge, and effective pedagogy to teach her students research-based best practices. Dr. Laverick's teaching methods include modeling as a way to demonstrate key concepts, providing authentic learning experiences, utilizing motivational strategies, incorporating service learning, and assessing her students' performance through a balanced approach that includes authentic methods. Dr. Laverick's teaching philosophy centers on being a positive role model with the goal of equipping her students with the knowledge, skills, and dispositions they need to make a positive and lasting impact on the lives of their students. Dr. Laverick's research agenda and service are closely aligned with her teaching practice, and she has authored and coauthored journal articles and book chapters based on her teaching methods. Dr. Laverick is the co-advisor for the Beta Gamma Chapter of Kappa Delta Pi, which is the international honor society for education.

### Distinguished Faculty Award for Service

**Michele Papakie**, Journalism and Public Relations

When Michele Papakie joined the faculty of IUP in 2007, she was thrilled that service would be one of her primary responsibilities. In the classroom, Dr. Papakie has tied a service component to nearly every course she has taught, and she easily models outstanding citizenship to her students and advisees. Because she chairs a small department, her service on almost every committee is a given. For her union, she chaired the Student-Faculty Liaison Committee, when a strike seemed imminent, and is a legislative assembly delegate. For her college, she has served as a Title IX trainer to sister departments. For her university, she and a team of 12 undergraduate students led the university's Strategic Visioning Project in 2013. Through that project, she earned a seat on the University Planning Council and the Middle States Steering Committee and the chapter writer position for Standard One's subcommittee. She is also an active academic advisor to six student clubs at IUP. In her community, she is running for her second six-year term as a Brush Valley Township supervisor, and she has been volunteering regularly at the Alice Paul House for four years. For her state and country, Lt. Col. Papakie serves as inspector general of the 171st Air Refueling Wing of the Pennsylvania Air National Guard and is proudly celebrating her 28th year of military service. In 2010, she served a six-month tour in Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

### Distinguished Faculty Award for Creative Arts

**W. Zachary Collins**, Music

Zachary Collins is an active musician as a performer and composer. In addition to performing on the IUP campus, he has in recent years appeared as a soloist with the Johnstown Symphony Orchestra and the IUP Wind Ensemble, as well as in solo recitals at the International Tuba Euphonium Conference, South Central Regional Tuba Conference, and North East Regional Tuba Euphonium Conference. For the past three years, he has served as acting principal tuba with the West Virginia Symphony Orchestra and was recently featured as soloist in the production *Tubby the Tuba*. He has been an active chamber musician, performing with the HoodleBug Brass, the faculty brass quintet at IUP, and Eastern Standard, a trio in which he is joined by IUP faculty members Heidi Lucas (horn) and Jacob Ertl (piano). Dr. Collins has toured with these ensembles throughout Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New York and has performed at the Northeast Regional Horn Workshop, North East Regional Tuba and Euphonium Conference, and Pennsylvania Music Educators Association Conference. Dr. Collins has also been active in commissioning new works for solo tuba and chamber ensembles and has premiered these works at the aforementioned conferences. In addition to performance, Dr. Collins is also an active composer. Several of his compositions for brass instruments have been published by Cimarron Music Press and Eighth Note Publications. His compositions have been performed by various collegiate ensembles at conferences that include the Southeast Regional Tuba Conference, North East Regional Tuba and Euphonium Conference, and International Tuba Euphonium Conference.

## DISTINGUISHED FACULTY AWARDS

### Distinguished Faculty Award for Research

**Benjamin Ford**, Anthropology

Benjamin Ford's research centers on historical and maritime archaeology, with a particular interest in how people use and modify the spaces they inhabit. His current research focuses on the maritime landscape of Lake Ontario's shore and on Hanna's Town, the Revolutionary War-era county seat of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania. Dr. Ford's work includes directing field surveys and excavations, both on land and underwater, in New York and Pennsylvania, as well as theoretical studies that synthesize previously published finds. Over the past five years, he has published 11 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters, as well as three edited books, including the *Oxford Handbook of Maritime Archaeology*. Beginning this summer, he will lead a multiyear National Park Service-funded investigation of Pennsylvania's Fort Necessity National Battlefield.

## THE SYMBOLS OF LEARNING

Participants in the commencement procession are attired in regalia that reflects a history and heritage that can be traced to the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries. Modern academic regalia evolved from the kinds of apparel worn by monks and students in the Middle Ages to keep warm in the medieval castles and halls in which they studied.

Academic life as we know it today began in the Middle Ages, first in the church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the Guild of the Master of Arts, and the Bachelor was the apprentice of the Master; their dress was the outward sign of stature and responsibility. Academic regalia was thus a visible manifestation—in color and pattern and design—that unified those of common discipline and like purpose.

In later centuries, to preserve the regalia's dignity and meaning, universities set rules of academic dress. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1895, establishing a code of approved attire. In 1932, the American Council on Education revised this code, which, for the most part, governs the style of academic dress today. The principal features of academic dress are three: the gown, the cap, and the hood.

**The Gown.** The flowing gown dates to the 12th century. Many think it was worn as protection against the cold of unheated buildings. It has become symbolic of the democracy of scholarship, for it completely covers any dress of rank or social standing. It is (with a few of institutional exceptions) black for all degrees. Pointed sleeves indicate the bachelor's degree; long closed sleeves with a slit in the arm, the master's degree; and round open sleeves, the doctoral degree. The gown for bachelor's or master's degrees has no trimmings; the gown for the doctoral degree is faced down the front with velvet and has three bars of velvet across the sleeves, in the color distinctive of the faculty or discipline in which the degree pertains.

The official colors of the college may also appear in the gown or its decorations. The trustees and some administrators of IUP wear gowns of slate trimmed in crimson velvet.

**The Cap.** The freed slave in ancient Rome won the privilege of wearing a cap, and so the academic cap is a sign of the freedom of scholarship and the responsibility and dignity with which scholarship endows the wearer. Old poetry records the cap of scholarship as square, symbolizing the book, although other authorities claim that it is a mortarboard, the symbol of the masons, a privileged guild. At the baccalaureate level, the color of the tassel on the cap denotes the discipline. The tassel is moved from the right side of the cap to the left side upon conferral of the degree.

**The Hood.** In regalia, the hood is an inverted shield with one or more chevrons of a secondary color on the ground of the primary color of the college. The color of the facing of the hood denotes the discipline represented by the degree; the color of the lining of the hood designates the university or college from which the degree was granted.

**The Mace** is a ceremonial staff carried by the chief university marshal, the most senior faculty member. The chief university marshal opens and closes all academic convocations, such as Freshman Convocation and commencement. Artist and metalsmith Walter J. Kipp, a 1942 graduate of Indiana State Teachers College, designed and constructed the mace for IUP in 1967. The design was created around the state seal, which was placed at the top of the mace. The large keystone which comes next symbolizes the state emblem, and on this keystone the letters IUP are placed. The handturned shaft is made of native Pennsylvania walnut.

**The President's Medallion** is worn by the president of the university during academic convocations as a symbol of the leadership responsibilities vested in that office. Michael A. Driscoll was the first president to wear the current medallion, featuring the university seal in antiqued silver and crimson. The IUP Design Studio designed this fourth presidential medallion in 2014, and Medallion Art Company constructed the piece. Walter Kipp made the original medallion in 1968 for the 15th president, William W. Hassler. Robert W. Hamilton, professor emeritus of art, created a replacement medallion in 1998, and Wendell August Forge crafted a third in 2005.



**The Philanthropy Cord** is worn as a symbol of philanthropic pride by the newest alumni who made gifts to the Senior Giving Campaign. This double-knotted gray and crimson cord symbolizes the reciprocal commitment between IUP and its alumni.

**The Study Abroad Cord** is a blue and green entwined cord that designates students who have participated in a one- or two-semester study abroad program during their studies at IUP. These students have studied in a wide variety of majors at universities throughout the world—and on every continent except Antarctica.

**The Punxsutawney Cord and Pin**, in crimson and gold, are worn by new graduates who originated their IUP study at the Punxsutawney Regional Campus. The crimson symbolizes IUP as the degree-granting institution, and the gold, the foundation of enlightenment, knowledge, and compassion acquired during the first year of baccalaureate study at IUP Punxsutawney.

**The Lavender Cord** is worn by individuals who identify across the spectrum of gender identity, gender expression, and/or sexual orientation. The color lavender represents a combination of the pink and black triangles gay men, lesbians, and some political prisoners were forced to wear in Nazi concentration camps.
