

**Abstract**

This collection contains digital information about the history and anniversary of Indiana University of Pennsylvania including the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary booklet of Indiana State Normal School (ISNS) from 1900, the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary postcard of ISNS (1925), the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary history of Indiana State Teachers College (1950), the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary (1875-1975), and the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the founding of Indiana State Normal School (2000). Box 2 of the collection is the 1975 IUP Centennial Time capsule.

**Box 2 IUP Centennial Time Capsule (Stapleton Library Room 301)**

1. 1975 Centennial Time Capsule (contents unknown): **Note:** Do Not Open until May 17, 2075, “On May 17, 1875, Indiana Normal School began its first session with 225 students in the only building on campus – what became known as John Sutton Hall.” In 1975, IUP celebrated its first one hundred years, and this time capsule was created.”
