Historical Note

The African American Cultural Center at Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP) was established as the Black Cultural Center (BCC) in the 1970s. Dr. Carolyn Princes became director of the BCC in 1990. The center became known as the African American Cultural Center (AACC) in July 1995. The purpose of the AACC was to enhance multicultural awareness and racial sensitivity. The African American Culture Center was integrated into the Center for Multicultural Student Leadership and Engagement (MSCLE), see also Record Group 48 Student Organizations and Record Group 40 IUP Division of Student Affairs.
