**Scope and Content**

The Office of International Education assists international students and scholars as well as their families from over 50 countries, and helps IUP students pursue educational opportunities abroad.

This collection documents the [Office of International Education](#) (OIE) at Indiana University of Pennsylvania (IUP). This office has changed names several times, but it was referred to as the Office for International Studies and later the Office of International Services before coming the Office of International Education. The collection includes documents and publications including the office newsletter *One World* and the *Global Engagement Gazette* (since 2024-2025), and information from the [Office of International Education](#) website.

Since the 1950s, IUP has hosted many international students who have participated in student organizations and programs, and the Office of International Education also created study abroad opportunities for IUP students. The office is affiliated with several student organizations, which have had a variety of names including the Foreign Students Club and the International Students Club, which are represented within this collection, but more information about these student organizations can be found in [Record Group 48 Center for Student Life](#).
